WHAT TO BRING (AND NOT TO BRING) TO SUMMER CAMP

Label EVERYTHING with Scout's Name. You've been warned. ☺

___ **Sack lunch:** for Sunday trip to camp, Troop will provide bottled water.

___ **Foot Locker: lockable, with wheels preferred:**

Ex: Contico Storage Locker. No duffle bags or luggage as clothes usually get wet.



___ **Key or Combination Lock**

CLOTHES

___ **Class A Uniform:** troop cap, bolo-tie, scout belt and socks. OA sash for OA members.

___ **Hanger:** to hang up uniform

___ **T1011 Class B T-shirts:** 2-3. You may purchase additional shirts. Your Scout will receive a new one on Wednesday at camp.

___ **Shorts:** 3-4, Scout uniform shorts if you have them

___ **Long Pants** (preferably nylon) and **Long Sleeve T-Shirt** for 1st year scouts taking swimming MB

___ **Underwear:** 5 at most (4 will be unused ☺)

___ **Socks:** 2-3 pair Scout socks, 3+ other socks

___ **Suggestion:** Pack socks and underwear in huge Ziplock

___ **Shower shoes:** Crocs, sandals, etc. **Note: for shower only.** Scouts must wear closed toed shoes in camp

___ **Jacket or Windbreaker:** gets cool at night in mountains

___ **Poncho or Rain Suit:** another must!

___ **Swim Trunks and Towel:** pack this last, on top, for easy access, swim test on arrival

___ **Tennis Shoes:** 1-2 pair as they may (re: will) get wet

___ **Sturdy Shoes** (such as hiking boots): 1st years will be take a 5 mile hike during week

___ **Sleeping Wear:** PJs, etc.

___ **Wrist Watch:** inexpensive, water resistant: use alarm to wake up and be at class on time

PERSONAL ITEMS

___ **Sleeping Bag & Pillow:** It can get cool at night in the mountains. Recommend a **Sheet**, too, for hot nights on top of bag

___ **Sleeping Pad:** even if sleeping on cots

___ **Small Day Pack or Book Bag:** carry water, personal items, MB books, etc.

___ **Mug:** insulated, plastic, with handle and name on bottom (troop will not bring cups)

___ **Water Bottles, 2:** Nalgene type: **THIS IS A MUST!**



___ **Toilet Kit:** tooth brush, soap, shampoo, towel, wash cloth, etc. (as if the later will ever be used. Ha!)

___ **Flashlight & Headlamp:** both types preferable plus **Extra Batteries**

___ **Pocket Knife:** only if have Totin' Chip, no sheath knives, switch blades, blades over 3"

___ **Personal First Aid Kit & Glide:** for chaffing

___ **Sun Screen and Insect Repellant:** wipes or pump, i.e. non-aerosol

___ **Notebook and Pencils:** MB classes

___ **Scout Book** with plastic cover and **Merit Badge Book(s)** for class

___ **\$30 - \$40:** spending or extra needed for merit badge items

___ **Compass**

___ **25'+ Clothesline:** hang up towels, swim suit, etc.

___ **Leisure Activities:** reading material, cards, games, Frisbee, football, etc.

___ **Landry Bag:** for dirty clothes. Hopefully this will be used before the last day. ☺

___ **Camp Chair**

___ Bert Adams only: **Bike & Helmet**

___ Other optional: **Hammock, Bandana, Fishing Gear**

DO NOT BRING THESE ITEMS

• No **ELECTRONICS** of any type. Period. No iPods, Smart or Cell Phones, DS, Radios, TVs, etc.

• No Inappropriate Reading Material. If you can't show it to Mom, don't bring it to camp.

• Neither any type of aerosol cans nor Butane lighters. **Extremely dangerous, camp forbids!**

• No junk food, snacks, candy, magazines, etc. (some like to sell to other scouts for profit, this has historically led to problems.) **There will be a Cracker Barrel every night.**



• No Mess Kits. Only need Plastic Mug and Water Bottle.

• No Fireworks, Fire Arms, drugs or alcohol. Obviously!!!
